Udstillingsaftale

Congratulations! Your tapestry "The House of the Faun" has been accepted into the American Tapestry Biennial 8 exhibition. We received 176 entries from 105 artists representing 15 countries. As you can imagine, the Juror, Rebecca A.T. Stevens had a very difficult choice, and you should be very proud to be included among the 65 tapestries included in the final exhibition.

As you may know, we were unable to secure an appropriate venue in Albuquerque, NM during the HGA Convergence. Thus the actual tapestries will not be needed until late August 2010, and we will be sending instructions as to when and where to ship them.

However, we do want to prepare the ATB8 catalogue prior to that, so that it will be available for attendees at Convergence 2010 and for the booth ATA will have at SOFA Santa Fe, both in July 2010. Although the exhibition will not be on display in New Mexico for these events, we expect the catalogue to generate interest in the exhibition.

Therefore, we will need the following information from you BY JANUARY 25, 2010:

Images:

- Tapestry:

Each image has to be no less than 2100 pixels at the widest dimension and saved in jpg format.

- Name each digital image with artist's name and tapestry title:

lastname.firstname_tapestrytitle.jpg (ie: doe.jane_tapestrytitle.jpg)

- Artist:

One digital image of the artist in color or black and white. No less than 400 pixels in height.

Name each digital image with artist's name and the word portrait:

lastname.firstname_portrait.jpg (ie: doe.jane_portrait.jpg)

Text: Supply text in Word format.

Statistics — For each tapestry accepted include:

- Artist Name
- Country
- Title of Tapestry
- Dimensions in inches or cm (height x width x depth)

Materials

- Name of Photographer

• Name the file with artist's name and the word stats: lastname.firstname_stats.doc (ie: doe.jane_stats.doc)

Also Include a file of:

- Artist Statement of 150 words or less
- Artist Bio of 50 words or less
- Phone number, address, web site and email
- Name the file with artist's name and the word statement:
lastname.firstname_statement (ie: doe.jane_statement.doc)

Also, you should be preparing your work for shipping and exhibition:

The Tapestry must be ready to hang when it arrives. Some suggestions may be found on the ATA web site:

When it is time to send the tapestry, it should be sent in a sturdy REUSABLE box or tube. Please label all packing materials. Several people will be working on the packing and unpacking, so having your name on all parts of the packing materials will help keep your package as you intend it to travel.

You will be responsible for shipping and insurance costs to the first venue and back again to you from the final venue. American Tapestry Alliance will pay the shipping and insurance during the exhibition only. Toward the end of the exhibition, we will collect payment information for return shipping to you.

Venues: we currently have contracts with 2 venues for the Biennial, and are waiting to hear about a potential third venue. ATB8 will open at Elder Gallery in Lincoln, Nebraska, (Sept 20 - Nov 15, 2010) during the meetings of the Textile Society of America. This will be an exceptional opportunity for your work to be seen by members of this prestigious organization.

From there, it will travel to the American Textile History Museum in Lowell, Massachusetts (Jan 21-May 1, 2011). This newly refurbished Museum has a very active outreach/ educational program. Most of its collection is historic they have been very interested in showing contemporary work.

If our application is accepted for the third venue, we would expect your work to be returned by the end of July 2011, otherwise it will come back at the end of the second venue.
